

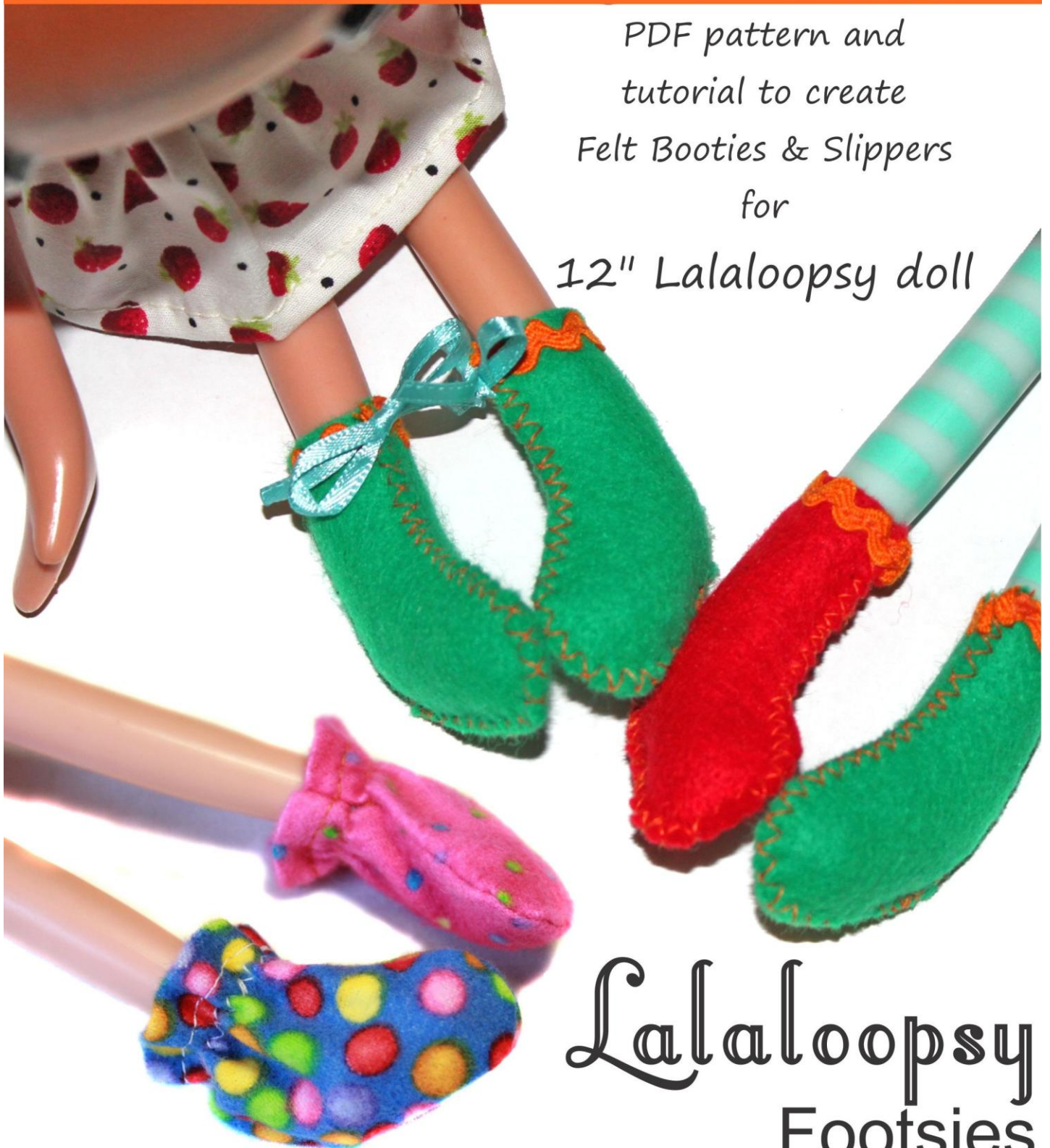


Doll Tag Clothing



PDF pattern and
tutorial to create
Felt Booties & Slippers
for

12" Lalaloopsy doll



Lalaloopsy Footsies

Doll Model Size

Designed for 12" Lalaloopsy Dolls

You Will Need

Booties – Felt remnants
Slippers – Flannel remnants
Narrow Rickrack
1/8" Narrow Elastic
Matching Thread
1/8" wide Ribbon for ties



Printing the Pattern

- Pattern pieces are at the end of the instructions. They are designed to fit on an 8.5" x 11" standard US paper.
- Check the scale of the pattern. No resizing necessary. Print files at 100%, "Scale None", or "Actual Size".
- If you are using A4 Paper set and your scale is not correct, set your printer to print "Letter" size.
- Simply cut out the pattern pieces or trace them onto pattern paper.

Booties Instructions

- ❖ Secure the beginning and end of your seams with a backstitch.
- ❖ Cut 2x Booties on fold from felt

1. Sew rickrack onto the top edge of the booties. Have a 1/2" of rickrack stick out on either side.
2. Fold the rickrack towards the inside and hold in place.



3. Cut a piece of ribbon 5". Burn or fray block the ends.
4. OPTIONAL: Fold the ribbon in half and align the folded side on the inside of the bootie. Overlap 1/4".



5. With wrong sides facing fold the bootie in half. Sew closed with a zigzag stitch (Stitch Length 2.5 and width 4). Sew on the edge of the felt making sure that you catch both layers.

Tie the ribbons to complete the booties!

Slippers Instructions

- Cut 2x Slippers on fold from flannel
1. Finish off the top edge of the slippers with a serger or zigzag stitch.
 2. Hem the slippers: Fold the top edge over 1/4" and sew.



3. Cut 2 pieces of elastic – length of 1.75" each.
 4. Place the elastic next to the hem line on the wrong side of the bootie. There is 1/4" of elastic to stick over the edges at the beginning and end of the seam. This is to hold onto when sewing.
 5. Sew the elastic down the centre with a small zig zag stitch (St Length 2 and stitch width 2). Pull the elastic so that it lies flat while you sew.
- Note: It takes quite some pull as the elastic is really short compared to the fabric.

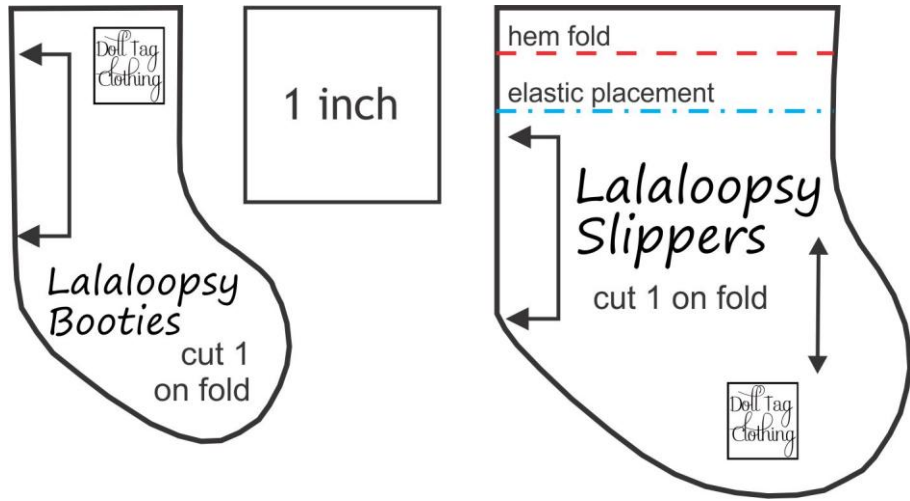


6. With right sides together fold the bootie in half and sew 1/4" seam from the hemline to the fold.
7. Cut the seam in half and sew a zig zag stitch on the edge. (St Length 2.5 and stitch width 2.5)



Turn slippers right side out to complete!





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
