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Doll Model Size

This pattern is designed to fit 18 inch soft body dolls. Head Circumference $-12 \frac{1}{4}$ "

Base Pattern

To create the base suit for my costume I used the Simply Bodysuits pattern (*sold separately*).

The bodysuit does not have feet but you can dress your scout with some cute sneakers or some red socks.

You will need

Fabric Guide — Felt is used for all three accessories

- White Felt − 7 x 20"
- Red Felt 6 x 12"
- Hook-and-loop Tape -2" (5/8" width cut in half to get 1/4" wide)
- 1/4" Wide Elastic 7"
- Matching Thread

Printing the Pattern

- Pattern pieces are at the end of the instructions. They are designed to fit on an 8.5" x 11" standard US paper.
- Check the scale of the pattern. No resizing necessary.
 Print files at 100%, "Scale None", or "Actual Size".
- If you are using A4 Paper set and your scale is not correct, set your printer to print "Letter" size.
- Simply cut out the pattern pieces or trace them onto pattern paper.

Before You Begin


- Seam allowance Sew a 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated.
- "Finish off the seam" Felt does not fray so the edges are not finished or fray blocked.



Cutting List & Layout

Collar — Cut 1 on fold Mittens — Cut 4 Hat Band — Cut 2

Hat — Cut 2



Collar Instructions

Note: Felt does not fray so you do not need to finish the edges.

1. Sew on the hook-and-loop for closure —

Cut hook-and-loop tape -2" long (5/8" width - cut in half to get about 1/4" wide)

Left back panel: Sew the soft side of the hook-and-loop on the outside of the collar back. Stitch on all four sides.

Right back panel: Sew the hook side of the hook-and-loop on the inside of the collar back. Stitch on all four sides.

The collar is complete!






Hat Instructions

1. With right sides together, align the hat band with the bottom curved edge of the hat. Sew. Finger press the seam down towards the hat band.


Repeat for the second side of the hat.



2. With right sides together, align the two hat sides. Sew closed the two sides. Re-enforce the stitches at the top point.



3. Clip the point being careful not to cut the stitches.



4. Turn the hat right side out and push the point out gently.

Optional: Hand sew a white pompom onto the top point of the hat.


The hat is complete!




Mitten Instructions

As you sew along, repeat each step for both mittens.

1. With right sides together, align the mitten front and back. On the one side, sew the seam from the edge down 1.5". Secure the stitches. Fold the seam allowance open.



2. Fold the top straight edge of the glove to the wrong side, 3/8". Sew close to the edge creating the elastic casing.




- 3. Cut two lengths of 1/8" wide elastic -3.5" each.
- 4. Thread the elastic through the elastic casing and pin at the openings to keep in place.




- 5. With right sides together, align the mitten front and back. Sew closed the rest of the mitten seam from the previous stitching to the top of the elastic casing.
- 6. Notch the seam allowance of the curve being careful not to cut the stitches.

Turn the mitten right side out.



The mittens are complete!

Collar Instructions

Note: Felt does not fray so you do not need to finish the edges.

1. Sew on the hook-and-loop for closure — Cut hook-and-loop tape — 2" long (5/8" width - cut in half to get about 1/4" wide)

Left back panel: Sew the soft side of the hook-and-loop on the outside of the collar back. Stitch on all four sides.

Right back panel: Sew the hook side of the hook-and-loop on the inside of the collar back. Stitch on all four sides.

The collar is complete

Hat Instructions

- 1. With right sides together, align the hat band with the bottom curved edge of the hat. Sew. Finger press the seam down towards the hat band.
 - Repeat for the second side of the hat.
- 2. With right sides together, align the two hat sides. Sew closed the two sides. Re-enforce the stitches at the top point.
- 3. Clip the point being careful not to cut the stitches.
- 4. Turn the hat right side out and push the point out gently.

 Optional: Hand sew a white pompom onto the top point of the hat.

Mitten Instructions

As you sew along, repeat each step for both mittens.
