Cozy Winter BEANIE
a Free Doll Tag Clothing pattern

You will Need

- 4-Ply Yarn (Fingering/Sport weight)
- Hook: Smaller Beanie - 3.25 mm (US D3)
Larger Beanie - 4 mm (US F5)
- Yarn Hand Needle
- Stitch Marker

Techniques and Stitches

Chain	Slip Stitch
Single crochet	Decrease
Double crochet	Crochet in rounds

Abbreviations

Ch	- chain	tr	- triple crochet	yo	- yarn over
sl st	- slip stitch	wsf	- wrong side facing	tog	- together
dc	- double crochet	rsf	- right side facing	dc dec	- dc decrease
sc	- single crochet	hdc	- half double crochet	sc dec	- sc decrease

Stitch Guide

- Dc - yo, insert hook in next st, pull yarn through 1 loop, yo, pull yarn through 2 loops, yo and pull through remaining 2 loops
- dc dec - yo, insert hook in next st, pull yarn through 1 loop, yo, pull yarn through 2 loops (2 loops on hook), yo, insert hook in next st, yo, pull yarn through 1 loop, yo, pull yarn through 2 loops, yo, pull yarn through remaining 3 loops on hook
- sc dec - draw up a single loop in each indicated stitch, yo, pull yarn through loops on the hook
- hdc - yo, insert hook in next st, yo, pull yarn through 1 loop, yo and pull through remaining 3 loops

About this Pattern

Crochet a beanie for your doll. This beanie can be worn as a slouch beanie as well. The pattern has been designed for dolls with a head circumference of 9 to 10 inches. There is a list of popular dolls that can wear these beanies. These include WellieWishers™, Hearts for Hearts, A Girl for All Time, Corolle les Cheries and Kidz ‘n Cats. Measure your doll’s head if you want to be sure this pattern is for you!

Measure your Dolls Head

To measure the head for this pattern you will need to measure the “crown” of the head. This is above the ears where a hat would normally sit.

Choose your Hook Size

By changing the hook size you can slightly alter the size of the final result. This pattern includes two sizes. For both you will use the same pattern, only the hook size is different.

- Smaller Beanie - 3.25 mm (US D3)
Includes: WellieWishers, Corolle les Cheries
- Larger Beanie - 4 mm (US F5)
Includes: Hearts for Hearts, Kidz ‘n Cats, A Girl for All Time



Gauge

3.25 mm (US D3) hook: 10 sc x 12 Rows = 2x2"
 4 mm (US F5) hook: 12 sc x 12 rows = 2x2"

Lets Crochet!

Crochet from the top of the hat in rounds

Main Color - Ch4, join in ch1 with sl st to form circle

Round 1: Ch4 (this counts as first dc), * **1dc in circle, ch1** *. Repeat from * 8 times, join with sl st on top of beg ch3 = 10dc (20 Stitches)



Round 2: Ch4 (this counts as first dc), * **1dc in space, ch1, 1dc in dc of previous round, ch1** *. Repeat from * all round, join with sl st on top of beg ch3 = 20dc (40 stitches)



Round 3: Repeat Round 2 = 40dc (80 stitches)

(The edge will start to ruffle)

Round 4: Ch4 (this counts as first dc), * **1dc in space, ch1** *. Repeat from * all round, join with sl st on top of beg ch 3 = 40dc (80 stitches)



Round 5: Ch3 (this counts as first dc), 1dc in space, ch1 * **1dc in next space, 1dc in next space, ch1** *. Repeat from * all round, join with sl st on top of beg ch3 = 40 dc (60 stitches)

(The edge starts to curl up to form a slight cup)

Round 6 & 7: Repeat Round 5 = 40 dc (60 stitches)

- Tip - To add slouch you can repeat round 5

Round 8: Ch1, sc in joining st, 3sc in next 3st , draw up lp in next 2 dc, yo and through all 3 lps on hook - sc dec made; * sc in next 4 st, sc dec over next 2 *; rep from * all around; join to first sc (50 stitches)

Round 9: Repeat Round 8 (42 stitches)

Round 10 - 13: Ch1, sc in each st around, join with sl st to first sc (42 stitches)



Tie off with long yarn left for sewing into beanie.

Your beanie is now complete and can be added to your doll's wardrobe!

Complete Size

Here are the sizes - more or less - that my beanies come out as. You can use this as a guideline for your own. The measurements do not have to be exact for a good fit as the crochet does stretch a little. It is best to use your doll to measure on.

Summary of Instructions

Crochet from the top of the hat in rounds

Main Color - Ch4, join in ch1 with sl st to form circle

Round 1: Ch4 (this counts as first dc), * **1dc in circle, ch1** *. Repeat from * 8 times, join with sl st on top of beg ch3 = 10dc (20 Stitches)

Round 2: Ch4 (this counts as first dc), * **1dc in space, ch1, 1dc in dc of previous round, ch1** *. Repeat from * all round, join with sl st on top of beg ch3 = 20dc (40 stitches)

Round 3: Repeat Round 2 = 40dc (80 stitches)
(The edge will start to ruffle)

Round 4: Ch4 (this counts as first dc), * **1dc in space, ch1** *. Repeat from * all round, join with sl st on top of beg ch 3 = 40dc (80 stitches)

Round 5: Ch3 (this counts as first dc), 1dc in space, ch1 * **1dc in next space, 1dc in next space, ch1** *. Repeat from * all round, join with sl st on top of beg ch3 = 40 dc (60 stitches)
(The edge starts to curl up to form a slight cup)

Round 6 & 7: Repeat Round 5 = 40 dc (60 stitches)

- Tip - To add slouch you can repeat round 5

Round 8: Ch1, sc in joining st, 3sc in next 3st , draw up lp in next 2 dc, yo and through all 3 lps on hook - sc dec made; * **sc in next 4 st, sc dec over next 2** *; rep from * all around; join to first sc (50 stitches)

Round 9: Repeat Round 8 (42 stitches)

Round 10 - 13: Ch1, sc in each st around, join with sl st to first sc (42 stitches)

Tie off with long yarn left for sewing into beanie.

Your beanie is now complete and can be added to your doll's wardrobe!
